

## Using a Windows system get Cadence Compatible using these steps.

Windows version of Cadence Desktop coming December 2009!

**System requirements:** Any Windows OS with iTunes installed

**Devices:** iPhone, iPod Touch, nano, Shuffle, Classic, or any iTunes compatible mp3 player

### Step 1: Analyze your library.

Download a BPM analyzer (like Beatunes or Mix Meister. Use analyzer to find the BPM values of all the songs in your iTunes library.

### Step 2: Create BPM playlists. [insert video tutorial icon with scroll over words ?watch video tutorial?]

Create a playlist folder in your iTunes music library called BPM. Download and import our playlist file (Download off our website in Get compatible section) into your iTunes library to create all the necessary BPM playlists (for example, a playlist called BPM 70-71 will contain all your songs with a BPM value of 70 and 71). Put all the playlists into the BPM folder you created. (If you can't see the BPM column in iTunes, click on your sorting options in iTunes and select BPM from the drop down list).

### Step 3: Sync playlists to your device.

Sync all the playlists within the BPM folder to your device.

**Note on DRM:** *If one of your favorite songs doesn't appear in one of your new playlists, it probably means that they could not be analyzed for their BPM value because they are DRM protected. If this is the case, you will need to manually enter the BPM for each song individually. Apple recently made their entire library DRM free so any music purchased now is fully analyzable. Apple offers the ability to upgrade already purchased music to DRM free for a small charge. For more information, check out <http://www.apple.com/itunes/whatsnew/>.*
